## **PROJECT OBJECTIVE**

THE AIM OF THIS PROJECT IS TO ADAPT AND EVALUATE A PILOT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FERYA PROGRAMME IN TWO EUROPEAN COUNTRIES. FERYA IS DESIGNED TO EMPOWER PARENTS' ORGANIZATIONS TO PREVENT RISKS RELATED TO SUBSTANCE USE THAT AFFECT THEIR CHILDREN. THE ELABORATION OF A PREVENTION PROGRAMME WITH A CONTEXTUAL APPROACH INCLUDING AN EVALUATION MODEL TO EXAMINE EMPOWERMENT OF THE ORGANIZATIONS, ASSESSMENT OF THEIR READINESS TO CHANGE, AND STRENGTHENING THEIR FOUNDATIONS TO ACTIVELY ENGAGE THEM IN PREVENTION WILL REPRESENT AN IMPORTANT ADVANCE IN THE FIELD OF COMMUNITY-ORIENTED CAPACITY BUILDING FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION.
