

PUBLIC NOTICE

(Post-Doctoral Research Fellowship - BIPD)

The Nursing School of Coimbra (ESEnFC) is opening a call for 5 (five) Post-Doctoral Research Fellowships (BIPD) for the Health Sciences Research Unit: Nursing (UICISA: E), A) 3 (three) under project ref. UIDB/00742/2020 and B) 2 (two) under project ref. UIDP/00742/2020. The grant will be funded by national funds through FCT/MCTES (PIDDAC) under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Nursing, Health Sciences, Social Sciences and related areas.

Grant recipients/Admission requirement: Applicants must hold a doctoral degree in aforementioned scientific areas for at least three years. According to the requirements in paragraph 3(b) of Article 7 of the Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships of the Foundation for Science and Technology (FCT, I.P.), the research leading to the award of a doctoral degree must not have been carried out at UICISA: E.

Preferred requirements: Expertise in scientific research methodologies. Experience in research activities. A high degree of proficiency in written and spoken English.

If the qualifications have been conferred by a foreign higher education institution, they must be recognized by a Portuguese higher education institution, in accordance with the provisions of Decree-Law No. 66/2018, published in Diário da República, 1st series, No. 157, of 16 August, and any formalities established therein must be fulfilled by the application deadline.

Areas of knowledge and Scientific Supervision:

- 1 - Study and development of a device to prevent needlestick injuries and contamination in nursing practices, under the supervision of Professor Pedro Miguel Santos Dinis Parreira.
- 2 - Flushing in the prevention of complications associated with peripheral venous catheters, under the supervision of Professor Anabela de Sousa Salgueiro Oliveira.
3. Citizen involvement in research and the extension of knowledge to society, under the supervision of Professor Sílvia Manuela Dias Tavares da Silva.
4. Person-centered care: from conceptual models to implementation, under the supervision of researcher Filipa Isabel Quaresma Santos Ventura.
5. To conduct research activities in the Research Unit within the framework of the integrated action project for the development of the Research Unit.

Applicable legislation and regulations: The Research Grant will be awarded in accordance with the Research Grant Holder Statute (Law no. 40/2004 of 18 August and Decree-Law no. 123/2019 of 28 August) and the Legislation and Regulation of Research Grants of the FCT, I.P. in force, Regulation no. 950/2019 of 16 December 2019 <https://files.diariodarepublica.pt/2s/2019/12/241000000/0009100105.pdf>.

Activity Regime: Awarding the grant does not create or establish a legal employment relationship, and it will be carried out on an exclusive dedication basis. The applicant receiving the grant will receive the status of grant holder, in accordance with the provisions of the Research Grant Holder Statute and the Research Grant Regulations of the FCT, I.P., both in their current wording.

Workplace: The work will be carried out at the UICISA: E, in Campus C of the ESEnFC, in Coimbra.

Grant duration: 12 months on an exclusive dedication basis, starting in September 2024.

Renewal: Possibly renewable for an equal period up to a maximum of 36 months, according to article 7(3) of the FCT Regulation for Research Grants.

Monthly maintenance stipend: The grant amount corresponds to € 1.801,00 according to the table of monthly maintenance stipends for FCT grants (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2024/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM_atualizacao-2024.pdf).

This monthly stipend will be paid by bank transfer at the end of the month. (The Voluntary Social Security corresponding to the first level of the scale of contributions will be added to this amount if the applicant chooses to receive it, as well as the personal accident insurance).

Selection methods: The selection criteria will be as follows (see annex):

Curriculum evaluation: Curriculum evaluation is calculated using the following formula: $AC = 10\% \cdot HA + 90\% \cdot EP$ where: **AC** - *Avaliação curricular* (Curriculum Evaluation), **HA** - *Habilitações Académicas* (Academic Qualifications), **EP** - *Experiência Profissional* (Professional Experience). The candidates will be ranked on a scale of 0 to 20.

The jury reserves the right to request additional information from the candidates about the submitted curricular information.

In the event that none of the candidates possesses the requisite profile (overall evaluation of less than 50%), the grant will not be awarded.

Application procedure: Applications must include the following documents: *Curriculum Vitae* (organized in the following manner: 1. Biographical data; 2. Academic and professional qualifications; 3. Professional experience, 3.1. Scientific publications, 3.2. Actions to disseminate science and technology, 3.3. Participation in R&D projects, 3.4. Other relevant professional activities); Motivation letter; copy of supporting documents attesting the qualifications and final grade; and other relevant supporting documents, namely attesting English language proficiency, the applicant's statement under oath indicating the type of grants they were awarded and their duration. Applicants with academic degrees obtained abroad must present a Certificate of Recognition according to the legislation in force (Decree-Law no. 66/2018, published in *Diário da República*, 1st series, no 157, of 16 August). This document is required only at the contracting stage.

All documents listed above must be sent in PDF format by e-mail. Applications submitted by other means (e.g., delivered by hand, sent by postal mail) will not be accepted.

Application submission: Applications must be submitted by e-mail to investiga@esenfc.pt with "UICISA_PD_2024_5" written in the subject line.

Publication/notification of results: The final evaluation results will be published in a ranked list at ESEnFC. The selected applicant will be notified via e-mail.

Application deadline: The call is open from 03 to 17 June 2024.

Additional information: The evaluation results will be sent to the applicants via e-mail up to 90 working days after the deadline for application submission. The final evaluation results will be published in a ranked list on the ESEnFC website at <https://www.esenfc.pt/pt/page/3684/165>. The selected applicant will be notified via e-mail. Applicants can request a prior hearing within ten working days after the final results have been announced.

Once the selection process is completed, the grant contract will be drawn up in accordance with the contract template made available by FCT.

Once the contract ends, the grant recipient and the supervisor must draw up the final report based on the established assessment criteria.

Selection reserve: The ESEnFC reserves the right to call on unsuccessful applicants, by ranking order, to recruit any additional grant holders necessary for the same project within 12 months after the applicants' notification of the final ranking list. If the selected applicant cannot meet the conditions required within one month of notification of the final ranking list, the ESEnFC reserves the right to cancel the call (in the case of a single candidate) or contact the next candidate to fill in the vacancy.


